1330*	8122	I monitor for weather questions <b>Eastern Pacific</b>
1415	8122	<b>Amigo Net.</b> My Forecast, <b>Ensenada to Socorro Island and Sea of Cortez to Puerto Vallarta to Acapulco.</b> The net moves to 4149 after weather. I continue to monitor 8122 until 1500 Z.
1445	7192	LSB <b>Chubasco Net.</b> I monitor for any emergency traffic.
1515	7233.5	LSB <b>Baja California Maritime Service Net.</b> My forecast <b>San Diego to Acapulco</b> including <b>Sea of Cortez.</b> Weekdays only. I am backup for AA6TP if needed on weekends.
1530	12359	I monitor 12C for weather questions usually 500 to 2500 miles from my station.
1545*	16534	I monitor 16C for weather questions from vessels in <b>North Atlantic</b> and <b>North and South Pacific</b> , out to 7000 mi from my station. 18840, 22165 and 25115 are alternate frequencies, especially for vessels beyond 4000 miles.
2345	12359	I monitor 12C for weather questions from vessels out to 2500 mi from my station.
0000*	16534	I monitor 16C for weather questions from vessels <b>North and South Pacific</b> , out to 7000 mi from my station. 18840, 22165 and 25115 are alternate frequencies, especially for vessels beyond 4000 miles.
0100	8122	<b>Southbound Net.</b> My brief update of Amigo weather plus any convection/chubasco information. The net moves to 4054 kHz

\*If nothing heard after 15 minutes I close down.

On Fridays early I have a men's breakfast /bible study meeting so no watch until afternoon.

On Sundays I close down for the rest of the day after the Amigo Net.
